Motion was made by Bradley and seconded by Stanbrough to approve the current agenda. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

Motion was made by Bradley and seconded by Stanbrough to approve the minutes from the Monday, March 30<sup>th</sup> and the Wednesday, April 1<sup>st</sup> meetings. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.
