Fayette County Conservation is offering an opportunity for an individual to join one of the longest standing roadside vegetation management departments in Iowa. The successful candidate will assist in managing natural resources in northeast Iowa where the prairies meet the driftless.

The purpose of this position is to assist the Roadside Manager in implementing a comprehensive roadside vegetation management plan for Fayette County. The Plan includes establishing and maintaining native vegetation, controlling weeds and woody vegetation, and providing erosion control to protect water quality.

Position requires a two year college degree and one year experience in a natural resources or conservation field or equivalent combination of education, experience and training which provides the required knowledge, skills and abilities.

***Must be 18 and possess a class A CDL with airbrake and tanker endorsement or the ability to obtain one within 60 days of hire.**

*** Certification as a public pesticide applicator in category 6 and 1A within 30 days of hire**

***Reside in Fayette County within 6 months of hire**
